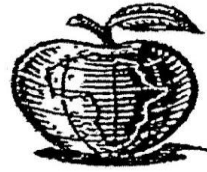

The Award will be in the amount of \$1,000.\* Scholarship recipients will be announced on June 14, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. during SABSE's Annual Student Recognition and Staff Retirement Reception at Mount Zion Baptist Church, 1634 Rev. Dr. S. McKinney Avenue, Seattle, WA 98122. Scholarships Awards will only be administered in the calendar year in which students were awarded the scholarship.

**\*Note: Financial awards will be sent to recipients upon completion of their first quarter/semester of college.**

Applicants will be considered based on the following criteria:

- 3.0+ GPA
- Community Service
- Leadership Skills
- Financial Need
- Written Communication Skills

Applicants must submit the following information no later than May 18, 2016:

- Application Form with Personal Essay
- Official Grade Transcript (sealed)
- Academic Recommendation from a teacher, counselor or administrator
- Personal Recommendation from an individual other than a family member
